PERFORMANCE BY PERIOD



The Value Equity Composite contains fully discretionary value equity accounts. The composite strategy seeks superior returns relative to the Russell 1000 Value Index by employing a time-tested quantitative strategy with a fundamental overlay. The performance inception date was February 1, 1993, and the creation date of this composite was April 1, 1993. The composite does not include accounts where the client restricts the purchase or sale of particular securities that results in more than 5 % of their holdings deviating from the model portfolio.
